



Core Skills: Advanced Bariatric & Roux-en-Y Laparoscopic Surgery

Thursday 15 June 2017



There has been a significant increase in the utilisation of procedures such as sleeve gastrectomy in the primary setting as well as for salvage from complications of gastric banding, which has resulted in an increased need for subspecialist upper GI and bariatric surgeons to consider bypass procedures more often.

This workshop aims to create an educational environment in which consultant surgeons and senior trainees are encouraged to exchange ideas and information pertaining to the latest advances in upper GI and bariatric surgery. Limited positions are available for Theatre Nurses in the role of assisting and scrubbing for surgical consultants and trainees.

The workshop will use a combination of pre-reading, didactic sessions, discussion and practical skill stations using fresh human cadaver material.
