



Generic Surgical Sciences Training Course

30 Online Presentations June 2024 to October 2024



In 2024 the GSS Training Course will be offered as 30 online presentation sessions over 25 topics, with the current session series now available to participants between June and October 2024. This training program aims to assist in improving knowledge and understanding and the application of anatomy, physiology and pathology as it pertains to surgical training.

The course materials will support study efforts as junior doctors prepare for the RACS Generic Surgical Sciences Exam (GSSE). They are offered over a secure online portal and comprise a series of recorded presentation sessions by expert faculty.

Participants will have the advantage of unrestricted access to study materials housed in the learning portal for the duration of the course. They will be able to utilise this online resource at their own pace and prioritise areas of learning across the breadth of material covered in the GSSE. A mock exam replicating the GSSE will be provided.

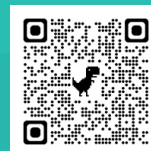
