The Cutting Edge: Managing Skin and Soft Tissue Injuries is a hands-on skills training workshop utilising synthetic and animal tissue simulation models. It aims to assist GPs whose practice includes more extensive management of acute and chronic injuries and is of particular relevance for rural GP Proceduralists.

Some suturing experience is recommended for participants to benefit from the procedural sessions.

Workshop Content

Demonstration and Practical Sessions:

- Skin biopsy and facial wounds
- Abrasions, abscesses and foreign bodies (simple)
- Simple lacerations and glue
- Difficult lacerations
- Wounds in difficult places
- Treating open fractures, including plastering techniques / back slabs
- Treatment options for clean lacerations

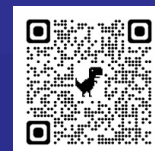
