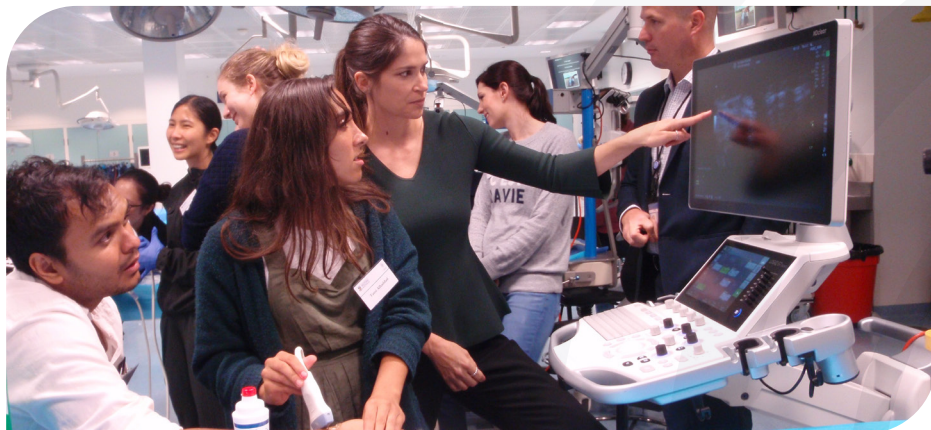


The Cutting Edge: Practical ED Skills

CTEC's new Cutting Edge: Practical ED Skills Workshop is an intensive hands-on skills training workshop utilising synthetic, live participant, animal tissue and cadaveric arm teaching models. It is of particular relevance for rural GPs, GP Registrars and Advanced Scope Nurse Practitioners, especially those working in hospital emergency settings.
